- **Pigtail:** Has a connector on one end and bare fiber on the other, designed for fusion splicing to a trunk or distribution cable inside a splice tray or closure. It is a permanent link and is not meant for direct device-to-device connections.
- **Patch Cord:** Has connectors on both ends and is used for flexible, reconfigurable connections between devices or panels. It is plug-and-play and ideal for front-side patching. If your goal is to connect active equipment directly, a patch cord is appropriate. If you are splicing into a fiber distribution network, a pigtail is required.

Connector and Fiber Type Considerations

Ensure the pigtail matches your network requirements:

- **Single-mode (OS2)** for long-distance or FTTH/PON applications.
- **Multimode (OM3/OM4)** for in-building or data center links.
