

AP can be directly connected to the aggregation layer switch



Article Overview

Yes, an AP can be directly connected to an aggregation layer switch, but proper configuration of VLANs, link aggregation, and forwarding modes is essential.

Direct Connection Considerations

Access Points are typically connected to the access layer, but they can be connected directly to an aggregation layer switch if the switch supports sufficient port density, PoE, and VLAN segmentation . When doing so, it is important to ensure:

- **VLAN Configuration:** Management and service VLANs must be properly assigned. If the same VLAN is used for both management and service traffic, APs may experience service interruptions .
- **Forwarding Mode:** In direct forwarding mode, APs send service packets directly to the upper-layer network without encapsulation in CAPWAP tunnels. This requires that the aggregation switch is configured to handle both management and service VLANs correctly .
- **Link Aggregation:** If the AP supports dual Ethernet ports, link aggregation (LAG) can be configured to increase bandwidth and provide redundancy. Both the AP and the aggregation switch must have consistent LACP settings, speed, duplex, and VLAN configuration .
