- **Mechanical Splicing** Mechanical splicing aligns fibers in a junction using adhesives or gels without fusing them. While easier and faster to perform, it has slightly higher signal loss and is typically used for temporary repairs or field deployments . Mechanical splices are less common in critical border networks due to durability requirements.
