

Cable Tray Laying and Installation Regulations



Article Overview

Cable tray installations must comply with NEC Article 392, IEC 61537, and relevant national standards to ensure safety, proper support, and electrical performance.

Key Standards and Guidelines

NEC (National Electrical Code) Article 392 governs cable tray systems in the U.S., specifying requirements for tray-rated cables, grounding and bonding, tray fill limits, voltage separation, and firestop measures at penetrations. Metallic trays must be properly grounded, and power and data cables require separation to prevent interference. Approved tray-rated cables are designed to withstand heat, moisture, and mechanical stress, ensuring safe and reliable operation. IEC 61537 is the international standard for metal cable tray systems, covering construction, load capacity, corrosion resistance, and electrical continuity. Compliance ensures trays can handle physical and electrical loads, maintain durability, and provide a safe grounding path. Materials include steel, stainless steel, and aluminum, with coatings or alloys selected for corrosion resistance in specific environments. British Standards (BS EN 61537 and BS 6946) provide guidance for cable ladder and tray systems, including channel supports. These standards emphasize that trays are for cable support only, not for walking or supporting personnel, and recommend installation by competent personnel familiar with electrical safety and wiring practices.

Installation Best Practices

- **Support and Spacing:** Trays must be supported at intervals specified by the manufacturer and standards to prevent sagging and maintain cable integrity.
