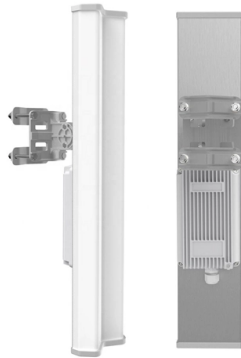


Cable length reserved in the distribution box



Article Overview

At least 6 inches of free conductor should be reserved inside an electrical box, with additional slack for bends, terminations, and future maintenance.

Code Requirements

According to the National Electrical Code (NEC), nonmetallic-sheathed (NM) cables must be secured within 12 inches of a box and at intervals not exceeding 4.5 feet along the run. The cable length between the entry point into the box and the closest support should not exceed 18 inches to prevent strain on the conductors and maintain safety compliance . This ensures that the cable is properly supported while leaving enough slack for connections.

Practical Slack Recommendations

For safe and functional installation, it is recommended to leave at least 6 inches of free conductor inside the box from the point where the cable sheath enters the enclosure . This length allows electricians to:

- Pull the device completely out of the box for connections
- Make splices or attach connectors without stress
- Perform maintenance or future upgrades without replacing the entire cable For smaller boxes with openings less than 8 inches, conductors should extend at least 3 inches beyond the edge of the box to ensure sufficient working space .
