Choosing the Right Cable Tray

- **Clearance:** Maintain sufficient distance from the electrical box to avoid contact with live terminals. A minimum of a few inches is recommended to comply with safety standards.
- **Support:** Use pre-drilled holes or mounting brackets to secure the tray to a wall, ceiling, or underside of a surface. Heavy-duty trays, like steel under-desk models, can support multiple cables and power strips.
- **Orientation:** Position the tray so cables run neatly without sharp bends. Forward or backward mounting options can help align with the electrical box and other devices.

- Avoid placing cables directly against the electrical box unless the tray provides insulation or separation.
