

Cable tray wall support dimensions



Article Overview

Cable tray wall supports are designed to securely hold trays with standardized widths, depths, and load capacities, ensuring compliance with NEC, NEMA, and IEC standards.

Standard Dimensions

Cable tray wall supports are engineered to match the tray dimensions, which typically include:

- **Width:** Nominal inside widths range from 50 mm (2 in) to 600 mm (24 in) for light to heavy-duty applications. The outside-to-outside width of the tray is slightly larger due to side rail thickness, which must be considered when mounting to walls .
- **Depth (Side Rail Height):** Common depths range from 50 mm (2 in) to 150 mm (6 in), controlling vertical cable stacking and heat dissipation .
- **Length:** Standard straight tray sections are usually 3 m (10 ft) or 2 m (6.5 ft), with wall supports spaced according to load class and tray type .

Wall Support Specifications

Wall supports are structural elements that attach trays to walls and provide mechanical stability:

- **Material:** Typically made from 16–14 gauge steel, aluminum, or stainless steel, depending on environmental conditions and load requirements .
- **Mounting:** Supports can be brackets, cantilever arms, or adjustable wall mounts, fixed to concrete, masonry, or steel structures using bolts, anchors, or mounting plates .
