

Cable tray wiring openings



Article Overview

Openings are permitted for cable tray wiring, provided the conductors are protected from abrasion and the openings are sealed or covered to prevent debris from entering equipment.

Permitted Openings

Cable trays are designed to support and route electrical conductors, and NEC Article 392 allows cables to transition from a tray into equipment through specific types of openings:

- **Bushed Conduit or Tubing:** Individual conductors or multiconductor cables with nonmetallic sheaths may enter enclosures through bushed conduit or tubing installed for protection. The conductors must be secured at the transition point, and the conduit or tubing must be sealed at the outer end to prevent debris from entering the equipment .
- **Flanged Connections:** Cables may also enter enclosures through openings associated with flanges from cable trays. The flange must be mounted directly to the equipment, and the opening must protect the conductors from abrasion and be sealed or covered to prevent debris ingress .

Requirements for Safety and Compliance

- **Protection from Abrasion:** All openings must ensure that cables are not damaged by sharp edges or mechanical stress during installation or operation .
- **Sealing:** Openings should be sealed using approved methods, such as duct seal, to prevent dust, debris, or moisture from entering the enclosure .
