

Cable trench distribution box



Article Overview

A cable trench should be properly designed for depth, protection, and accessibility, with cables entering the distribution box through correctly sized conduits and following safety and wiring standards.

Trench Design and Depth

When installing a cable trench, ensure compliance with IEC standards for underground cable laying, which specify proper depth, bedding material, and spacing to prevent mechanical damage and overheating. Depth depends on voltage level, soil conditions, and protection type, with higher voltage cables requiring greater burial depth. Protective ducts can reduce depth in controlled environments, but local regulations must always be consulted. Bedding material should provide stability and drainage, and the trench should allow easy access for maintenance.

Cable Routing and Protection

Cables should be laid in the trench with adequate separation between power and control cables to reduce faults and improve lifespan. Multiple runs may be required depending on the panel rating, with cable ties spaced at approximately 15-inch intervals and support arms at 30-inch spacing. Ensure that the bending radius of cables is not less than the allowable minimum to avoid damage, and avoid side entrances or grade changes in the trench.
