

Can a router be connected to a fiber optic line

How Routers Work with Fiber

Fiber optic internet transmits data as light signals through fiber cables, which requires an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert these signals into an Ethernet connection for your router. Unlike DSL or cable internet, fiber does not use a traditional modem. The ONT is typically provided and installed by your ISP, and your router connects to it via an Ethernet cable.

Router Compatibility

To use a router with fiber internet, ensure it has:

- A Gigabit Ethernet WAN port to handle high-speed connections.
- Support for your plan's speed tier; older routers may limit performance if your fiber plan exceeds 1 Gbps.
- Modern Wi-Fi standards like Wi-Fi 6 or Wi-Fi 6E for optimal wireless performance.
- Optional SFP ports if you want direct fiber input, though most home setups use the ONT as an intermediary. Routers designed for DSL or cable (with phone line or coaxial inputs) are not compatible with fiber.
