Traditional switches typically use RJ45 ports for copper Ethernet cables, which are suitable for short-distance connections within a building or server room. Copper cables are cost-effective and widely used for standard LAN connections, supporting speeds from 10 Mbps up to 10 Gbps depending on the cable type and switch capabilities. Fiber optic connections are used when high bandwidth, long-distance, or secure transmission is required. Fiber can carry data over several kilometers without signal degradation and is immune to electromagnetic interference, making it ideal for connecting switches across buildings, campuses, or data centers .

Fiber-Enabled Switches

Many modern switches include SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) or SFP+ slots, which allow the insertion of fiber optic transceivers. These modules can support single-mode or multimode fiber, depending on the distance and network requirements. Some switches also have combo ports, which can accept either an RJ45 copper connection or an SFP fiber module, but only one can be active at a time .
