

Can cables be branched in cable trays



Article Overview

Cables are branched in cable trays using fittings such as tees, crosses, and drop-outs, which allow the main tray run to split and route cables to different areas or equipment.

Methods of Branching

1. Tees and Crosses:

- Tee fittings create a single branch from the main tray, allowing cables to divert to another path.

- Cross fittings allow multiple branches from a single intersection, useful when routing cables to several directions from a main run . 2. Horizontal and Vertical Bends:

- Horizontal bends (30°, 45°, 90°) redirect cables along the same plane.

- Vertical bends (risers) allow the tray to change elevation, enabling cables to branch to different floors or equipment levels . 3. Reducers:

- Used when transitioning from a wider main tray to a narrower branch tray, ensuring proper support and organization of cables . 4. Drop-Outs:

- Allow cables to exit the tray vertically to connect directly to equipment below, maintaining neat routing and minimizing stress on the cables .

- Spacing and Support: Maintain proper spacing between cables to prevent overheating and ensure accessibility for maintenance .
