Fiber provides: Increased internet signal bandwidth. Most modern fiber-enabled network switches require an SFP transceiver module. SFP transceiver modules are specific to the type of fiber being connected (either single mode or multimode). Always. In addition, fiber cables can transmit data over several kilometers without signal degradation, making them ideal for connecting switches in large campus networks and between different buildings.
