

Can't a China Unicom fiber optic cable be used with a China Telecom router



Overview

In most cases, yes, you can use your existing router with fiber optic internet, provided it has a WAN (Wide Area Network) Ethernet port and your ISP provides a modem/ONT with an Ethernet output. We highlighted how this new service offering was driving a new round of ONT purchases—particularly in China—where new fiber subscriber additions had begun to moderate a bit from their peak. Compatible router: Verify that your router supports fiber optic input (look for an SFP or WAN port labeled). Fiber internet transmits data using light signals through fiber-optic cables, which differs from traditional DSL or cable internet. Instead of a modem, fiber connections require an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), a device that converts fiber signals into an Ethernet connection. Most fiber ISPs. just connect the optic cable to the telecom router and connect your personal router to the telecom one by ethernet cable, remember to use the 1gbs port and not the 100mbps ports. The critical factor is not the *type* of internet coming. The New Cross Pacific Cable System is a 13000km new generation high capacity fibre-optic submarine cable system across the Pacific Ocean directly connecting the US and Asia with landings in China, Korea, Taiwan, Japan and the US. The NCP cable system consists seven fiber pairs, initially.
