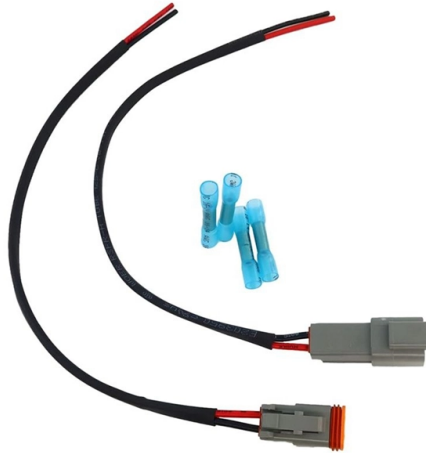


Can the fiber optic cable of a router be bent
