Communication Towers

Purpose and Function: Communication towers, also known as telecom towers, are designed to support antennas, microwave dishes, and radio transmitters. - **Monopole Towers:** Single, vertical poles made of steel or concrete, ideal for urban areas with limited space. They are aesthetically clean but support fewer antennas than lattice towers .
- **Lattice Towers:** Open steel frameworks with three or four legs, providing high stability and load capacity. Common in rural or suburban areas where multiple antennas are needed .
- **Guyed Towers:** Slender structures stabilized by guy wires, cost-effective for tall installations in areas with ample land .
