Configuring routers and core switches involves setting hostnames, interfaces, VLANs, routing protocols, security, and management features to ensure efficient and secure network operation.

Router Configuration

Access and Modes: Begin by accessing the router through console or SSH. Enter privileged mode to allow configuration changes, then switch to global configuration mode to modify interfaces, routing, and security settings . **Basic Settings:**

- **Hostname:** Assign a meaningful name for identification on the network .
- **Passwords and Access:** Configure console, VTY, and enable passwords to secure access .
- **Banner Message:** Set a login banner to warn unauthorized users .
- **Disable DNS Lookup:** Prevent the router from resolving mistyped commands as domain names .
- **Interface Configuration:**
 - Enable interfaces using no shutdown.
 - Set IP addresses, speed, and duplex settings to match connected devices .
 - Verify with show ip interface brief.
- **Routing and NAT:**
 - Configure static or dynamic routing protocols (e.g., OSPF, EIGRP) to manage traffic between subnets.
 - Implement Network Address Translation (NAT) if connecting to external networks .
