

Connecting wires from the building s electrical distribution box



Article Overview

To safely connect wires to a distribution box, first turn off the main power, then connect the incoming supply to the main breaker, distribute phase and neutral wires to the appropriate breakers, and ensure proper grounding.

Safety First

Before starting, always switch off the main power supply to prevent electrical shock. Use insulated tools and wear protective gear. Ensure the distribution box is securely mounted at an accessible height, in a dry, ventilated area, and free from obstructions.

Understanding the Distribution Box

A typical distribution box contains:

- Main MCB (Double Pole): Acts as the main isolator for incoming power.
- Single-Pole MCBs: Protect individual circuits.
- RCCB/RCD: Provides protection against earth leakage.
- Neutral and Earth Links: Distribute neutral and grounding connections to all circuits.

Step-by-Step Wiring Process

- Connect Incoming Supply: Attach the live (phase) and neutral wires from the main power source to the input terminals of the main MCB.
