Fiber optic pigtail heads are classified by connector type, fiber mode, core count, and polish type, with each type suited for specific network applications.

Connector Type

Pigtail heads are defined by the factory-installed connector on one end. Common connector types include:

- SC (Subscriber Connector): Push-pull design, widely used in data centers and telecom networks .
- LC (Lucent Connector): Small form factor, ideal for high-density applications .
- FC (Ferrule Connector): Screw-on type, often used in high-vibration environments .
- ST (Straight Tip): Bayonet-style, common in legacy networks .
- MPO/MTP: Multi-fiber connectors for high-density multi-core applications .

Fiber Mode

Pigtails are also classified by fiber mode, which affects transmission distance and wavelength:

- Single-mode (SMF, OS2): Yellow sheath, supports long-distance transmission (up to 40 km), wavelengths 1310nm or 1550nm .
- Multimode (MMF, OM1/OM2/OM3): Orange or aquamarine sheath, suitable for short-distance connections (up to 500m), wavelength 850nm .
