These cables are designed to withstand moisture, temperature fluctuations, UV exposure, abrasion, rodents, and mechanical stress .

Cable Construction

Direct burial cables come in several constructions:

- Loose-tube cables: Fibers are housed in gel-filled or gel-free tubes, protecting against microbending and water intrusion. Commonly used for long outdoor runs .
- Ribbon cables: High-density flat ribbons allow mass-fusion splicing, enabling faster installation and restoration .
- Armored cables: Include a metal layer (usually corrugated steel) beneath the outer jacket for crush and rodent protection, ideal for high-risk areas like rocky soil or road crossings .
