Material Selection

- Steel trays are commonly used for strength and durability, but standard hot-dip galvanized steel offers limited fire resistance because the zinc coating can melt at high temperatures .
- Fire-coated steel trays provide an insulating layer during a fire, making them suitable for high-risk areas like pump rooms .
- FRP (fiberglass-reinforced plastic) trays with thermosetting resins are lightweight, corrosion-resistant, and fire-resistant, making them another viable option .
- Avoid thermoplastic trays in fire-prone areas, as they can melt and exacerbate fire spread .
