What is Fiber Optic Splicing?

Fiber optic splicing is the process of joining two separate fiber optic cables end-to-end to form a single continuous fiber. It is used to extend cable length, repair broken fibers, or connect different types of fiber cables, such as combining a 48-fiber cable with multiple 12-fiber cables. Unlike connectors, splicing provides a permanent or semi-permanent connection with minimal light loss (attenuation) and back reflection, making it the preferred method for long-haul or critical network installations .

Types of Fiber Splicing

- **Fusion Splicing** Fusion splicing uses an optical fiber fusion splicer, a high-tech machine that aligns and melts the fiber ends together using an electric arc. This method produces a strong, low-loss connection (typically 0.02-0.1 dB) and is ideal for outdoor or long-distance networks. The process involves:
 - Stripping the protective coating from the fiber
 - Cleaning the fiber to remove dust or contaminants
 - Cleaving the fiber ends with a precision cleaver
 - Aligning the fibers using cameras and motors
 - Fusing the fibers with heat
