

Does the router allocate fiber optic cables in megabits

Routers do not allocate fiber optic bandwidth in megabits; they distribute the data provided by the fiber connection, which is already measured in Mbps by your ISP.

How Fiber Internet Works

Fiber-optic cables transmit data as light pulses, allowing extremely high-speed communication with minimal signal loss . The incoming light signals from the fiber line are first converted into electrical signals by an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which is typically installed by your ISP . The ONT determines the maximum speed of your connection, often in gigabits per second (Gbps), which is then passed to your router via an Ethernet cable .

Role of the Router

A router does not set the speed of the fiber connection itself. Instead, it manages and distributes the data coming from the ONT to multiple devices in your home or office . The router's capabilities, such as support for gigabit or multi-gigabit speeds, Wi-Fi standards, and Quality of Service (QoS) settings, determine how efficiently it can handle and prioritize traffic, but the total bandwidth in Mbps is defined by the fiber service provided by your ISP .
