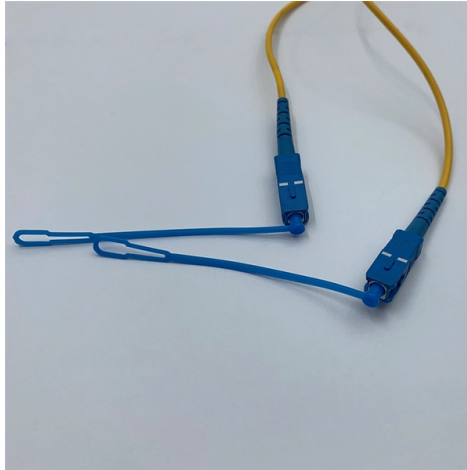


Dutch explosion-proof logging fiber optic cable



Article Overview

Explosion-proof fiber optic cables from the Netherlands are designed to safely transmit data in hazardous areas, complying with IEC 60079-28 and ATEX/IECEX standards.

Overview

Explosion-proof fiber optic cables are used in industrial environments where flammable gases, vapors, or dust are present. Unlike copper cables, fiber optics do not conduct electricity, eliminating sparks or arcs that could ignite explosive atmospheres, making them ideal for Zone 1 or Zone 2 areas . However, fiber cables must still be mechanically robust and properly enclosed, as concentrated light from damaged fibers can generate heat capable of igniting gases .

Safety Standards

- IEC 60079-28: Governs the use of optical radiation in explosive atmospheres, including limiting optical power and implementing automatic shutdown if a fiber is damaged .
- ATEX Directive (2014/34/EU): While ATEX primarily certifies devices, fiber optic systems must be installed in a way that maintains the overall explosion protection of the system .
- Protection Concepts: “op is” (low-energy output) and “op sh” (automatic shutdown on fiber breakage) are key methods to prevent ignition in hazardous areas .
