Properly connecting cable trays to electrical boxes ensures safety, system stability, and compliance with electrical codes.

Key Considerations

Safety and Code Compliance: Connections must follow the National Electrical Code (NEC) Article 392, ensuring proper grounding and load handling. Aluminum trays should not be used as grounding conductors for circuits above 600 amperes, and all connections must maintain the minimum cross-sectional area for grounding conductors . **System Stability:** Secure connections prevent sagging, cable damage, and potential electrical hazards. Properly joined trays support the weight of cables and maintain alignment over long runs .

Connection Methods

- **Splice Plates and Bolted Connections:**
 - Flat metal plates with pre-drilled holes are bolted to the ends of tray sections or to the electrical box flange.
 - Provides a strong, reliable connection suitable for straight runs and heavy loads.
 - Requires tools such as spanners or torque wrenches and allows for future disassembly .
- **Quick Connect Systems:**
 - Snap, slide, or twist mechanisms designed by specific manufacturers.
 - Fast installation with minimal tools, ideal for large projects where speed is critical.
 - Usually compatible only with the same manufacturer's trays .
