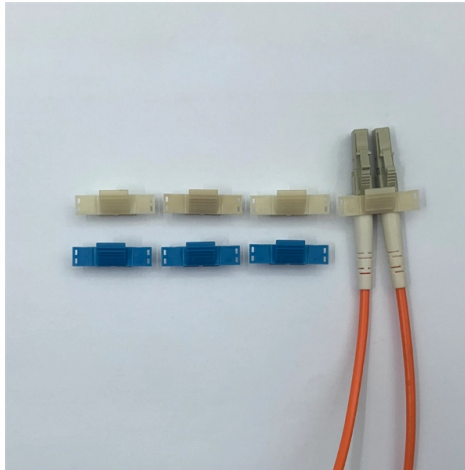


Elevation for cable tray fabrication

Elevations must be determined for either the top or bottom of the tray run. Compute precise cable tray offset geometry, run lengths, and diagonal travel dimensions for tray routing elevation changes. Calculate true diagonal travel lengths, horizontal runs, and bend geometry for ladder.
