- **PoE++ (IEEE 802.3bt):** Delivers up to 60W or 100W per port, enabling power-hungry devices like HD cameras, digital signage, and PoE lighting .

Data Transmission: PoE switches function as standard network switches, routing data efficiently using MAC addresses and supporting Fast Ethernet or Gigabit speeds .
