Core Components and Connections

Switch Ports and Fiber Types: Fiber optic switches typically have SC, LC, ST, or FC ports supporting single-mode or multimode fiber. Single-mode fiber is used for long-distance connections between central offices and buildings, while multimode fiber is ideal for shorter distances within buildings or campuses (EdrawMax) . **Media Converters:** In residential or mixed networks, media converters translate optical signals to copper-based signals for devices like computers or routers, ensuring compatibility with existing infrastructure (EdrawMax) . **Redundant Paths and Ring Topology:** For industrial or enterprise networks, switches are often connected in a ring topology, where each switch links to two others, forming a closed loop. This allows data to flow in both directions, providing failover in case of a link failure (Come-Star) .

Example Diagram Layout

- **Central Switch (Core):** Connects to the ISP or main network backbone using single-mode fiber.
- **Distribution Switches:** Connected via multimode fiber to the core switch, distributing data to different floors or departments.
