The ST (Straight Tip) connector is a cylindrical fiber optic connector with a bayonet-style twist-on locking system, providing secure and stable connections for network equipment such as routers and switches. ST connectors are widely used in both commercial and industrial networks due to their reliability and ease of insertion and removal. They support both single-mode and multimode fibers, ensuring effective data transmission across fiber optic systems ().

Single-mode Fiber (SMF)

- Core Diameter: Approximately 9 μm
- Light Transmission: Allows only a single mode of light, minimizing modal dispersion
- Distance & Bandwidth: Supports long-distance transmission with high bandwidth and low signal loss, ideal for backbone networks and long-haul communication ()
- Wavelengths: Typically 1310 nm or 1550 nm
- Applications: Telephone networks, cable TV, and high-speed internet over long distances
- Attenuation: OS1 single-mode cables have low attenuation (0.3-0.4 dB/km), enabling superior signal integrity ()
