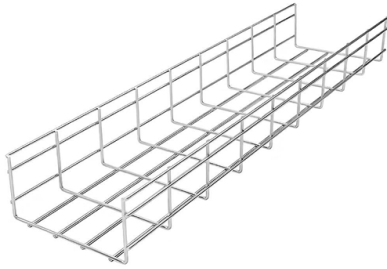


Fiber Optic Switch NP Mode



Overview

The NP fiber-optic switch is designed to meet the most demanding switching requirements of fast response time, and continuous switching operation at high repeat rate. The switch is intrinsically bidirectional and selectable for polarization-independent or polarization-maintain by. The NP (NanoSpeed Premium) Series 1×4 or 1×3 solid-state fiber optic switch is made of cascaded three 1X2 premium switches. We connect optical channels by redirecting an incoming optical signal into a selected output optical fiber.
