

Fiber Optic and TP Router Setup

You can set up a TP-Link router with fiber optic internet by connecting it to an ONT, configuring PPPoE or dynamic IP, adjusting VLAN settings if needed, and setting up Wi-Fi and LAN parameters.

Step 1: Connect the Fiber Optic Cable

Most fiber connections terminate at an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) provided by your ISP, which converts the light signals from the fiber into electrical signals your router can use. Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT and power it on. Wait for the status lights to stabilize, usually 2–5 minutes.

Step 2: Connect the TP-Link Router

Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN port to the WAN port of your TP-Link router. Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.

Step 3: Access the Router Interface

Open a web browser and enter the router's default IP address, typically 192.168.0.1. Log in using the default credentials (usually admin/admin). Once logged in, you can configure the network settings.

Step 4: Configure WAN Connection

Depending on your ISP, you may need to set up a PPPoE connection with a username and password provided by your ISP, or select Dynamic IP if no credentials are required. For some ISPs, you may also need to configure VLAN settings (e.g., VLAN 7 or VLAN 10) to ensure proper internet and IPTV service.
