A fiber optic cable can be permanently connected to a pigtail using fusion splicing, creating a low-loss, stable optical connection.

What is a Fiber Optic Pigtail?

A fiber optic pigtail is a short length of optical fiber with a factory-terminated connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other. The connector end plugs into equipment, patch panels, or optical distribution frames, while the bare fiber end is designed to be spliced to the incoming fiber cable in the field. This allows for precise, low-loss connections without the need for field-installed connectors, which are less reliable and more time-consuming to install.

Fusion Splicing Process

Fusion splicing is the preferred method for connecting a pigtail to a fiber optic cable. The process involves:

- **Preparation:** Strip the protective jacket and coating from the fiber cable and the pigtail to expose the bare fiber.
- **Cleansing:** Clean the fibers with alcohol wipes to remove dust and debris.
- **Alignment:** Place the fibers in a fusion splicing machine, which precisely aligns the cores of the two fibers.
- **Fusing:** The machine uses a micro-electric arc to melt and fuse the fibers together, forming a permanent joint.
