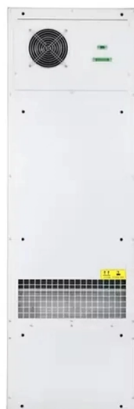


Fiber optic cable removal construction



Article Overview

A fiber optic cable removal plan requires careful site assessment, permit acquisition, utility coordination, safe cable handling, and environmental management to ensure compliance and minimize disruption.

1. Site Survey and Planning
