

Fixing points for cable tray cover plates



Article Overview

Cable tray cover plates can be securely fixed using pressing plates, screws, clips, welding, magnets, hooks, padlocks, or buckle systems, depending on installation requirements and cover type.

Common Fixing Methods

- **Pressing Plate Fixing** This method involves punching holes in the cover plate, placing a pressing plate over it, and securing both the cover and tray with screws through the perforations. It is suitable for both horizontal and vertical installations and provides strong, reliable attachment .
- **Screw Fastening** The cover plate is punched, and screws or rotating plate buckles are used to fasten it to the tray. This method allows for easy adjustments and is effective for both horizontal and vertical installations .
- **Buckle Fixing** The cover plate is secured by bending folds at the ends of a buckle without punching holes. This method is simpler but provides limited strength and is generally recommended only for horizontal installations, as vertical covers may slip .
- **Padlock Fixing** Covers can be locked using padlocks for added security, particularly in areas where access control is important. This method is often combined with other mechanical fasteners .
- **Seven-Shaped Buckle Fixing** A specialized buckle design that hooks the cover onto the tray, providing moderate security and quick installation. Suitable for light to medium covers .
