Common Causes

1. **Circuit Overload** The most frequent cause is an overloaded circuit, which occurs when too many devices draw power from the same circuit, exceeding its rated amperage (typically 15 or 20 amps) . Symptoms include breakers tripping when multiple appliances are in use, dimming lights, or warm outlets. Examples include running a microwave and toaster oven on the same kitchen circuit or using multiple space heaters simultaneously . 2. **Short Circuits** A short circuit happens when a hot wire contacts a neutral or ground wire, causing a sudden surge of current . This usually trips the breaker immediately when a device is turned on. Signs include sparks, a burning smell, or a breaker that trips instantly even when no appliances are connected . 3. **Ground Faults** Ground faults occur when a hot wire touches a grounded surface, such as a metal outlet box or water pipe. These are particularly dangerous in wet areas like bathrooms or kitchens and are detected by GFCI breakers or outlets .

Troubleshooting Steps

- **Prioritize Safety:** Before resetting, unplug all devices and turn off switches on the affected circuit .
- **Reset the Breaker Properly:** Push the breaker fully to the “OFF” position, then back to “ON” .
