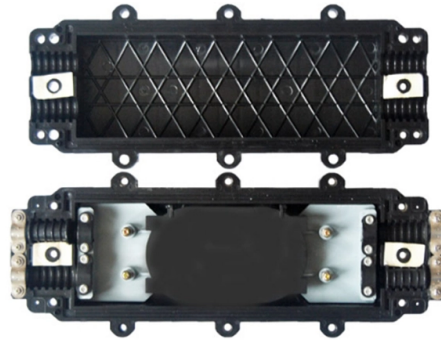


Function of the control busbar in the distribution cabinet
