What is a Distribution Box?

A distribution box (also called a breaker box, panelboard, or DB box) is the central hub of a home's electrical system. It receives electricity from the main supply and distributes it to various circuits throughout the house, such as lighting, outlets, and high-power appliances . The box ensures electricity is delivered safely and efficiently while preventing damage from electrical faults. It typically consists of a metal or plastic enclosure housing key components like circuit breakers, fuses, busbars, and sometimes RCDs or RCBOs .

Key Components

- **Main Switch:** Controls the entire electrical system, allowing the home to be shut down for maintenance or emergencies .
- **Circuit Breakers:** Protect individual circuits by automatically cutting off power during overloads or short circuits. Types include:
 - **1P (Single Pole):** Protects the live wire only.
 - **1P+N (Single Pole + Neutral):** Protects both live and neutral wires.
 - **2P (Double Pole):** Provides full isolation for both live and neutral wires, ideal for high-power appliances .
