Overview

QSFP transceivers combine four independent electrical channels into a single compact form factor, enabling scalable bandwidth from 40 Gbps to 1.6 Tbps through successive generations. The technology supports multiple protocols including Ethernet, InfiniBand, Fibre Channel, and SONET/SDH, making it. QSFP, known as Quad Small Form-factor Pluggable, is a four-channel small form-factor pluggable optical module with four independent full-duplex transceiver channels. It interfaces a network device motherboard (for a switch, router, media converter or similar device) to a fiber optic cable. Simply put, it supports 4x10G or 4x14G SFP+ data rates to enable increased bandwidth capabilities. Choose by port density, target bandwidth, distance, and thermal budget.
