

How many small busbars are there on the 10kV cabinet top voltage

The number of small busbars on a 10kV cabinet top voltage typically depends on the switchgear design, but medium-voltage cabinets usually have three main phase busbars, with additional small busbars for auxiliary connections.

Medium-Voltage Busbar Configuration

In a 10kV metal-enclosed switchgear cabinet, the top voltage section generally contains the main busbars that distribute power to incoming and outgoing feeders. According to standard medium-voltage switchgear design (IEC 62271-200), the main busbars are usually arranged in a three-phase configuration, corresponding to the three phases of the system. Small busbars are often used for auxiliary circuits, control wiring, or interconnections between cubicles. Their number varies depending on the cabinet type:

- Incomer cubicles: Typically have three main busbars (one per phase) plus small auxiliary busbars for control and protection circuits.
- Feeder cubicles: Connect the main busbars to outgoing feeders and may include additional small busbars for measurement, metering, or protection relays.
- Bus coupler or bus riser cubicles: May include extra small busbars to interconnect sections of the main busbar system or to provide redundancy.

Factors Affecting the Number of Small Busbars

- Cabinet design and manufacturer: Different switchgear manufacturers may provide varying numbers of auxiliary busbars.
