

How to Quickly Assemble a Fiber Optic Router

To assemble a fiber optic router, connect the fiber line to an ONT, link the ONT to your router via Ethernet, power on the devices, and configure the router settings for optimal performance.

Step 1: Gather Necessary Equipment

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts fiber signals into Ethernet for your router .
- Compatible Router: Ensure it supports fiber input (look for WAN or SFP ports labeled "ONT" or "Fiber"), .
- Fiber Optic Cable: Usually a thin yellow cable with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- Ethernet Cable: To connect the ONT to the router .
- Power Adapters: For both the ONT and router.

Step 2: Install the Optical Network Terminal (ONT)

- Locate the fiber optic wall outlet where your ISP's fiber line enters your home .
- Connect one end of the fiber optic cable to the wall outlet and the other to the ONT's designated port .
- Plug in the ONT power adapter and turn it on. Wait 2-5 minutes for the status lights to stabilize .
