

How to apply the specifications for cable tray supports



Article Overview

Proper cable tray support requires adherence to NEC standards, correct load calculations, appropriate support spans, and suitable mounting methods to ensure safety and compliance.

Understanding Standards and Requirements

Cable tray installations must comply with NEC Article 392, which governs the use, installation, and construction of cable tray systems, including permitted cable types, fill capacities, and grounding requirements . Additionally, trays should conform to NEMA VE 1 standards to ensure mechanical integrity and load-bearing capacity . For industrial applications, DIN EN 61537 provides guidance on material selection, corrosion protection, and environmental suitability .

Selecting the Right Tray and Material

Choose the tray type based on application, cable type, and environmental conditions:

- Ladder trays: Provide excellent ventilation and convenient cable tie points.
 - Ventilated troughs: Allow airflow while protecting cables.
 - Solid-bottom trays: Used where heat buildup is minimal or for aesthetic purposes .
- Materials typically include steel or stainless steel, often with galvanization or other corrosion-resistant finishes for durability .
