

How to connect fiber optic cable to a socket box

What a Fiber Wall Socket Is

A fiber wall socket, also called an optical termination outlet or FTTH outlet, is a dedicated interface where the incoming fiber optic cable terminates and connects to devices like routers or Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) in your home or office . It protects the delicate fiber end from dust, bending, and physical damage while providing a clean, organized access point for network equipment .

How Fiber Cables Connect

- **Termination:** The incoming fiber cable is typically fusion-spliced to a pre-terminated pigtail inside the socket box .
- **Adapter:** The socket contains an adapter (e.g., SC/APC, LC) that holds the fiber connector securely .
- **Patch Cable Connection:** A fiber patch cable is then plugged from the wall socket to the ONT or router, completing the connection .

Installation Considerations

- **Location:** Install the socket near your ONT or router, avoiding areas with potential interference or physical hazards .
