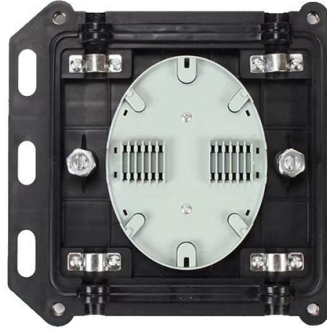


How to connect flat optical cables

To connect a flat optical cable, ensure device compatibility, clean the connectors, align the cable with the port, and insert it gently until it clicks securely.

Step 1: Verify Compatibility

Before connecting, confirm that both devices support optical connections. Look for ports labeled “Optical,” “Digital Out (Optical),” “TOSLINK,” or “Optical In/Out” on your devices. Toslink is the most common type for audio, while Mini-Toslink may be used for laptops or portable devices . Ensure the cable type matches the port size.

Step 2: Prepare the Cable and Ports

- Remove any protective caps from the cable ends.
- Clean the connectors and ports with a soft, lint-free cloth or specialized optical cleaning tools to remove dust or debris, which can degrade signal quality .
- Avoid bending the cable sharply; maintain gentle curves to prevent damage to the fiber inside.

Step 3: Align and Insert

- Hold the flat optical cable by the connector, not the cable itself.
- Align the square-shaped connector with the port. The connector should fit naturally into the port without forcing it .
- Gently push the connector until it clicks or fits snugly. Do not twist or apply excessive force.
