

How to connect high-voltage power to the distribution box

Safety First

Before starting any connection, ensure all power sources are turned off and verify with a multimeter that no current is flowing. Always wear insulated gloves, use proper tools, and follow local electrical codes. High-voltage work should ideally be performed by a licensed electrician.

Preparing the Distribution Box

A distribution box serves as the central hub for distributing electricity to multiple circuits. It typically contains circuit breakers, fuses, and terminal connectors. Ensure the box is securely mounted, level, and, if outdoors, waterproof with a rain cover. Proper spacing inside the box is necessary for heat dissipation and safe wiring.

Wiring High-Voltage Lines

- Identify the input lines: High-voltage lines usually include phase wires, neutral, and ground. For single-phase 240V systems, there are two hot wires (Line 1 and Line 2) and a neutral.
- Connect to the main breaker: Securely attach the hot wires to the lugs of the main circuit breaker. The neutral wire connects to the neutral busbar, which is bonded to the grounding bar for safety.
