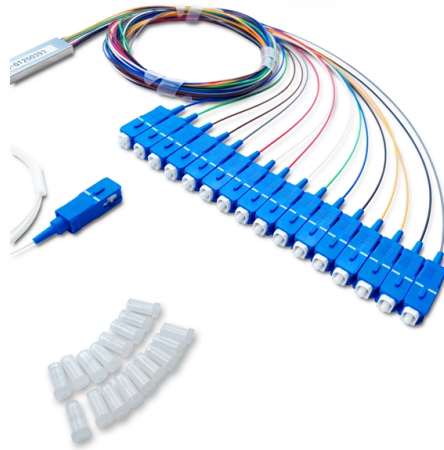


How to connect the power connector for a network cabinet



Article Overview

Connect the power to a network cabinet by first grounding the cabinet, routing input power cables to the PDU, using industrial-grade connectors like CEE plugs, and securing all connections while maintaining proper cable management and airflow.

Step-by-Step Guide

1. Prepare the Cabinet and Power Cables Ensure the cabinet is properly grounded using the metal frame or designated grounding points. Remove any protective panels or rodent-proof meshes to allow cable entry, and plan the cable routes to avoid blocking airflow or interfering with network cables (). 2. Identify the Power Input and PDU Locate the Power Distribution Unit (PDU) inside the cabinet. Modern racks often use vertical PDUs mounted along the rear frame, which convert a single incoming power feed into multiple outlets for IT equipment (). 3. Use Industrial Connectors For high-current or three-phase power, use industrial-grade connectors such as CEE plugs. These connectors provide secure locking mechanisms, color-coded voltage identification, and are designed for repeated use in data center environments (). 4. Connect Input Power Cables

- Connect the ground cable first to ensure safety.
 - Connect the input power cables to the PDU, following the manufacturer's instructions for terminal insertion and screw torque. Ensure the cord end terminal is fully inserted and tightened to prevent loose connections ().
 - If the PDU has a locking device, loosen it before inserting the plug and tighten it afterward.
