

How to distinguish between A and B terminals on a network patch panel



Overview

A and B are just two different colour to pin mappings. You insert the guide card displaying the one you want to use and then follow it. Yes, wire 568B on the other end. But keep in mind that most modern switches are auto-mdix, so even if you wired it 568A on the other end it. If you're still finalizing your patch panel approach (keystone vs punch-down vs pass-through), start with how to choose a patch panel and come back here once your hardware and workflow are set. Pick either T568A or T568B and standardize it everywhere. The scheme itself doesn't change Ethernet. A. A patch cord or keystone jack terminated from memory passes a quick continuity beep, gets installed, and works fine at 100 Mbps — then the link quietly drops to a slower negotiated speed, fails a certification scan, or starts dropping PoE-powered devices once real traffic hits it.
