

How to insert an optical fiber into an optical module

To connect an optical fiber to an SFP or optical module, ensure compatibility, clean the connectors, insert the module and fiber carefully, and verify TX/RX alignment for proper signal transmission.

Step-by-Step Guide

1. Verify Compatibility Ensure the SFP module and fiber optic cable are compatible in terms of fiber type (single-mode or multimode), wavelength, transmission distance, and connector type (LC, SC, FC, MPO) before installation . Single-mode fibers must be paired with single-mode SFPs, and multimode fibers with multimode SFPs. 2. Prepare the SFP Module and Fiber

- Insert the SFP module into the network device port (switch, router, or media converter) until it clicks into place .
- Remove the dust caps from both the SFP module and the fiber optic connectors.
- Inspect and clean the fiber end faces using a fiber cleaning tool to reduce insertion loss and prevent signal degradation . 3. Connect the Fiber
- Align the keyed notch on the fiber connector with the slot on the SFP module.
- Gently insert the fiber connector until it clicks or locks in place. If the SFP has a lock tab, push it down to secure the connection .
- Ensure the TX (transmit) port on one device connects to the RX (receive) port on the opposite device to establish proper communication . 4. Secure and Label
