

How to measure photovoltaic terminals with a multimeter

You can measure photovoltaic terminals by using a multimeter set to DC voltage or current, connecting the probes to the panel's positive and negative terminals, and recording the readings under sunlight.

Safety Precautions

Before starting, ensure safety: wear insulated gloves and safety glasses, work in a dry area, and disconnect the panel from any inverter or battery system to prevent accidental shocks or short circuits . Use a multimeter rated for at least 600 V DC for solar panels .

Measuring Voltage (Open-Circuit Voltage, V_{oc})

- Set your multimeter to DC voltage (VDC). If it is not auto-ranging, select a range slightly higher than the panel's rated voltage (e.g., 0-20V for a 12V panel, 0-200V for higher-voltage panels), .
- Connect the red probe to the positive terminal and the black probe to the negative terminal of the PV panel .
- Expose the panel to direct sunlight and read the voltage displayed. This is the open-circuit voltage (V_{oc}), which should be close to the manufacturer's nameplate value .

Measuring Current (Short-Circuit Current, I_{sc})

- Set the multimeter to DC current (A) mode. Use a clamp meter if available to avoid disconnecting wires .
