

How to quickly thread cables through cable trays

Use proper tray supports, quick-connect systems, and cable-laying tools to efficiently thread cables while maintaining safety and organization.

Plan and Prepare

Before threading cables, plan the tray route carefully. Mark the path using a laser level or straight line to ensure alignment and avoid unnecessary bends or obstacles . Choose the appropriate tray type (ladder, perforated, or solid-bottom) based on cable type, airflow needs, and load capacity . Ensure the tray is properly mounted and supported, with hangers spaced according to load requirements (typically 1.5–3 meters apart), .

Use Efficient Tray Supports

Center-hung or trapeze hangers allow cables to be deposited from each side, reducing the need to lift cables over the tray edges . This method minimizes physical strain and speeds up installation, especially for long runs.

Employ Quick-Connect Systems

For connecting tray sections, quick-connect or snap-together systems significantly reduce installation time compared to traditional bolted connections. These systems often require minimal tools and allow trays to be joined securely in a fraction of the time, which also facilitates faster cable threading . Using such systems ensures smooth tray surfaces, preventing cables from snagging.
