

How to secure cables in a ladder-style cable tray



Article Overview

Cables in a ladder-style cable tray should be secured using proper bundling, tie methods, and spacing to prevent sagging, maintain bend radius, and withstand mechanical forces.

Bundling and Tying Cables

Cables should be packed in bundles using appropriate banding or cable ties, ensuring the bundles are balanced at the center of the tray to distribute weight evenly and prevent excessive stress on the tray rungs or supports (BEAMA guide). Use non-metallic or metallic cable ties rated for the environment and temperature, and avoid over-tightening to prevent cable damage .

Spacing and Placement

- Rung spacing: Maintain a rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150–230 mm) for ladder trays to provide adequate support and prevent sagging, especially for heavy or large cables .
- Tie intervals: Secure cable bundles at regular intervals along the tray, typically every 24–36 inches, depending on cable weight and type.
- Separation of cable types: Keep power, control, and data cables separated to reduce electromagnetic interference and facilitate maintenance .
